

# A Country Tour: Organs North of the Hunter, NSW

This year's OHTA conference will provide an opportunity to travel through the picturesque midnorth coast, the New England and Upper Hunter regions of New South Wales.

The area to be covered includes many delightful small towns and villages and the cities of Newcastle, Port Macquarie and Armidale. The tour will include some 21 organs, including the work of the following builders: William Davidson, J.E. Dodd, Estey Organ Co., George Fincham & Son, Griffin & Leggo, Halmshaw & Son, A. Hunter & Son, Ron Mapstone, Nicholson & Co., Charles Richardson, A.L. Scott, J.W. Walker & Sons, Whitehouse Bros., and Henry Willis & Sons.

The conference fee includes coach transport from Sydney on Sunday 27 September (3.15 pm departure from outside Central Station - Bay 14 Eddy Avenue), returning to Hornsby station and then Sydney Airport (Domestic Terminal) on Saturday 3 October. Return flights should not be booked earlier than 5.00 pm, to allow for potential delays.

All accommodation, all breakfasts, four dinners and three lunches, together with seven morning or afternoon teas are included with full registration. (The \$2.60 cost of the ferry across the Hunter River to Stockton is not included: those with Opal cards can use them on this sector).

#### PROGRAMME SUMMARY

**Sunday 27 September:** Although not part of the conference, we advise that Jonathan Dimmock (of San Francisco) is giving a recital at Christ Church St Laurence Sydney at 2.00 pm. The coach departs from Bay 14, Eddy Avenue, less than 10 minutes' walk away from Christ Church. We will arrive at Christ Church Cathedral, Newcastle, for Evensong at 6.00 pm, followed by a recital and examination of a French harmonium, with dinner and an overnight stay at the Travelodge, Newcastle.

**Monday 28 September:** Visits to organs in Stockton (after a ferry ride across the Hunter River – there will be an uphill walk), followed by organs in Raymond Terrace, Gresford and Dungog. Overnight in Taree.

**Tuesday 29 September:** Visits to organs in Port Macquarie and Kempsey, with a paper on Methodist Church Music in NSW. Overnight in Coffs Harbour.

Wednesday 30 September: Travel to Dorrigo National Park for rainforest walks and waterfall viewing. Then to Armidale, with lunch at historic Booloominbah, part of the University of New England. Four organs will be heard in Armidale, with dinner at Wesley Church and a recital and a short hymn festival. Overnight in Armidale.

**Thursday 1 October:** Visits to organs in Armidale, Quirindi and Murrurundi, with two nights in Scone.

**Friday 2 October:** Visits to organs in Denman, Muswellbrook and Scone, with an audio presentation by Simon Colvin featuring Hunter organs and performances by Michael Dudman. Wine tasting and lunch at Hollydene Estate, Jerrys Plains.

**Saturday 3 October:** Return to Sydney, with lunch and a short recital at Newcastle Museum. Departing at 1.15 pm, the coach will stop at Hornsby Station and Sydney Domestic Terminal. Participants should avoid booking flights before 5.00 pm, to allow for potential delays.
