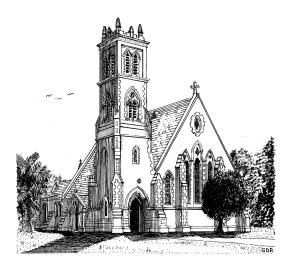

Past Evidence Future Keys

The 2008 OHTA annual conference is to take place in Victoria, based in Melbourne and Bendigo, in the Victorian countryside. The theme of the conference will be the technical documentation of significant pipe organs and how this information can be used to facilitate accurate restoration and reconstruction. The keynote speaker will be Paul Peeters, from Gothenburg, Sweden, the President of the International Association for Organ Documentation. Recitals will take place by notable performers James Tibbles (Auckland), Elmo Cosentini (Vienna), Sam Allchurch (Melbourne), and Peter Jewkes (Sydney). There will be visits to significant organs by the local builders William Anderson, George Fincham, Alfred Fuller, Hill, Norman & Beard, Daniel Lemke and William Stone, and the overseas builders Bishop & Son, Hamlin & Son, Hill & Son. Merklin et Cie. Frederick W. Nicholson, R.A. Randebrock, Henry Willis, Wurlitzer – and anon. There will also be time in Bendigo to explore this significant Victorian city and its splendid buildings, gardens and art gallery.

PROGRAMME SUMMARY

Monday 29 September: Registration followed by first seminar session on organ documentation - keynote address by Paul Peeters. Official opening followed by recital by James Tibbles (Auckland, NZ) at St Mary's Star-of-the-Sea Church, West Melbourne (George Fincham 1898-1900). Afternoon visit to St Kilda – organs by Fincham & Hobday 1892, George Fincham & Son 1909 and Hill & Son 1859 / Meadway & Slatterie 1916 – recital by Sam Allchurch.

Tuesday 30 September: Visits to organs on the Mornington Peninsula including instruments by Frederick W. Nicholson 1862, Daniel Lemke, c.1885, William Anderson c.1874, anonymous English 1850s and then ferry ride to Queenscliff – George Fincham 1871. Dinner in Queenscliff.

Wednesday 1 October: Visits to organs in the eastern suburbs of Melbourne, starting at Scotch College Memorial Hall, Hawthorn (Hill, Norman & Beard 1930) – recital by Peter Jewkes (Sydney) and then organs at Hawthorn, Glen Iris, Box Hill and Blackburn by Fincham & Hobday1892 /

Thursday 2 October: Visits to organs at Daylesford, Clunes and Dunolly in the Victorian Goldfields region by William Anderson 1888, George Fincham 1871, Hamlin & Son c.1867 and George Fincham 1879. Dinner in Bendigo.

Friday 3 October: Morning free to explore Bendigo. Second documentation seminar followed by visit to Sacred Heart Cathedral, Bendigo – organs by Bishop & Son 1904, Laukhuff-Revell 1982, anonymous c.1865 with recital by Elmo Cosentini (Vienna). Dinner in Bendigo.

Saturday 4 October: Visits to organs in Bendigo by Alfred Fuller 1882 and R.A. Randebrock 1871. Lunch at Heathcote residence and visit to organs - Alfred Fuller 1897 and Rudolph Wurlitzer 1928.

Coach departs 2.30 pm arriving at Melbourne Airport 4.00 pm – do not book any flights scheduled to leave before 5.00 pm. Bus arrives central Melbourne 4.30 pm.
