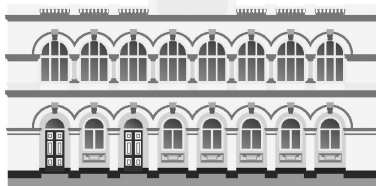
## REDUNDANT, RECYCLED AND RENOVATED

The 2003 OHTA Conference will take place from Saturday 27 September to Wednesday 1 October. Starting in the border city of Albury, the conference will include recitals, lectures, heritage tours, and visits to notable organs in the Riverina district of New South Wales and in north-east Victoria, including the historic towns of Beechworth, Wangaratta, Echuca, Wagga Wagga, Narrandera and Hay. Here there is a diverse range of instruments by local and overseas builders such as Bevington, Cook, Edwards, Fincham, Létourneau, Noad, Richardson, Walcker and Willis.

One of the areas the conference will be focussing upon is the moving of organs to new locations, of which there are many successful examples in this region, together with the work of NSW builders such as T.C. Edwards and S.T. Noad.

### Saturday 27 September

Albury: morning lectures; afternoon heritage walk and organ visits including modern Létourneau organ at St Matthew's Church and dinner to follow.

### Sunday 28 September

Beechworth: visit to historic town, buildings and organ. Wangaratta: visit to Cathedral - recital on Bevington and Willis organs, papers, Evensong and dinner.

### Monday 29 September

Visits to Fincham organ at Walla Walla and Edwards organ at Tumut, with its fine Blacket church. Afternoon at Wagga Wagga with organ visits and recital at Cathedral.

### Tuesday 30 September

Visits to organs at Junee and Narrandera with stops at Leeton (winery) and Griffith - modern Cathedral by Louis Williams, arriving at Hay in the evening.

### Wednesday 1 October

Visit to important Walcker organ at Hay Cathedral; Deniliquin and Echuca - three historic organs in attractive waterfront heritage town. Coach returns to Albury in afternoon.
